"Stop The Hate!" Campus Hate Crime Prevention program supports colleges and universities in preventing and combating hate on campus as well as fostering the development of community. This Train the Trainer Program is a collaborative partnership between ACUI and experts within various agencies directly involved with hate crimes and human rights issues. Organizations partnering to assist with this effort include the National Center for Hate Crime Prevention, Anti-Defamation League, National Gay and Lesbian Task Force, and the Center for the Prevention of Hate Violence. Key expert facilitators will be selected to maximize participants' ability to impact his/her college campus as a trainer on hate crime prevention.

BENEFITS OF TRAINING:

- Model Hate Crime Prevention Program with 200+ page curriculum manual divided into twelve different learning modules for training on your campus
- Skills and information to train students, faculty, and staff on anti-hate initiatives

Participation in this Train the Trainer Program is open to members of the college community (students, faculty, and staff) with the goal of providing trainers in each ACUI region. These trainers work as a part of a consortium of educators to combat hate on campus for the following year with his/her specific action plans to address hate in his/her region. To maximize the learning outcomes and preparation of knowledge for trainers, the program has been extended over three days with new activities and also an optional special track on hate crimes throughout the conference program.

Training will begin on Friday, March 15 at 5 p.m. and continue until 3 p.m. on Sunday, March 17 as a preconference program to this year's annual conference "**New Visions, New Directions, New Horizons, New Mexico**" in Albuquerque, New Mexico prior to the Regional Meetings & Opening Banquet. A special track for hate crime prevention trainers will be provided throughout the conference program and will feature the "Best Practices" of the 2001 hate crime prevention trainers as well as an opportunity to debrief on the training experience. The Train the Trainer program capacity is limited to only 45 participants with a registration fee of \$225 for ACUI members. ACUI non-members may register for a fee of \$275 for the training. The fee includes all program materials, Friday dinner, Saturday lunch and dinner as well as Sunday lunch. Registration, final costs, and times will be detailed in the 2002 annual conference overview and registration materials to be mailed to all ACUI members in early October. Some regions may have determined limited funding resources to support registration costs associated with this training opportunity.
